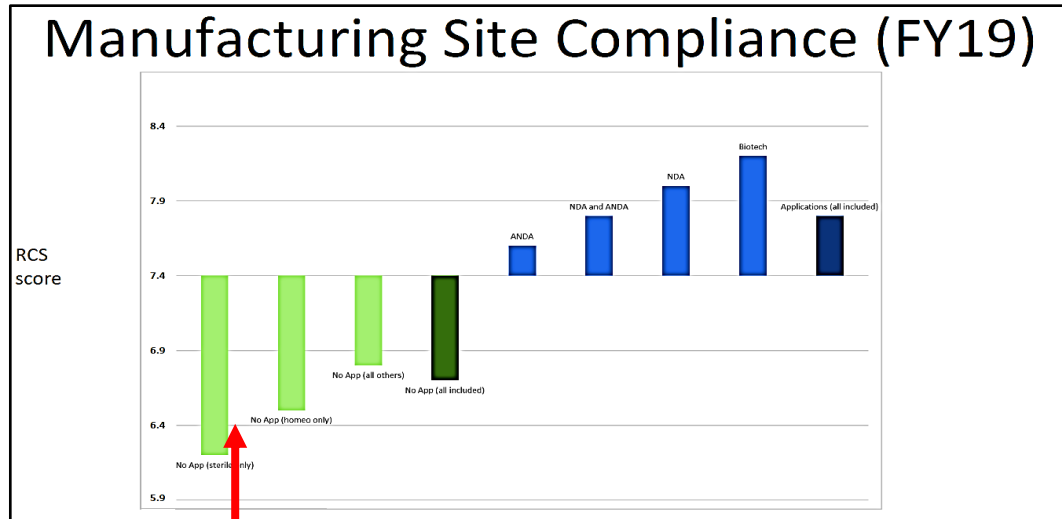
Introduction to AAHP

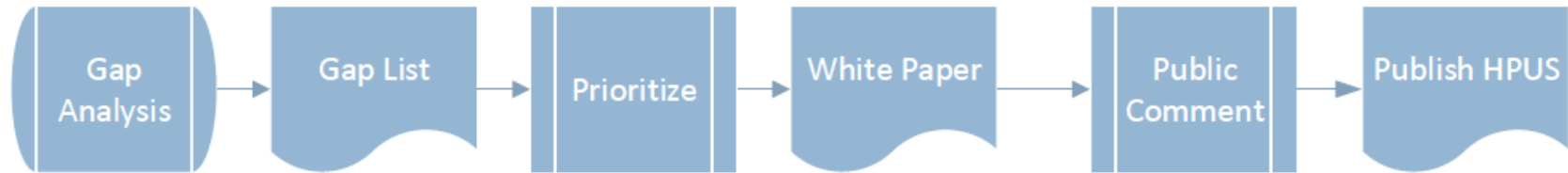


Homeopathic Manufacturing Sites

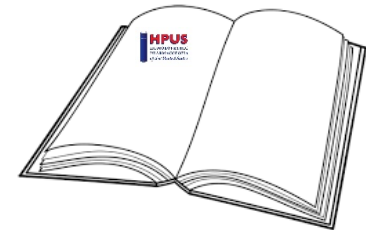
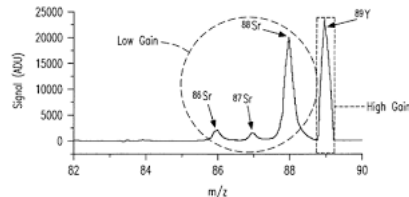
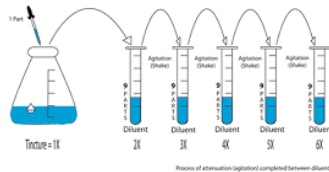
